



## MIDDLEVILLE







FOR THOSE of us fortunate to call Middleville home, we find it to be a great place for you and your family to enjoy the atmosphere. Sidewalks galore to walkabout and bike ride safely. A riverside trail featuring views of wildlife and fauna. Parks and recreation areas to relax within and picnic. And, many, many activities year around to keep you entertained.

As you pass through the Village you are greeted by people with a "hello" or a wave of a hand. No matter if you are in the older part of town or the newly established housing areas the homes are well kept and show the folks who live here truly have found Middleville to be a "place to call home!"

Middleville has established a rich heritage since its founding in 1834. Countless hundreds of people have worked diligently through this past half century to bring us to the community we have today. Members of many Village Councils, past Village leaders, members of numerous Boards, Commissions and Committees have worked hard to foster the changes in Middleville. This is in addition to private investment dollars in the community.

The Thornapple Township boards through the years have worked with the Village in seeking progress in the town. There was a time in the early 60's when we needed to build new homes. It was pointed out that lending institutions would only service mortgages in the community if it were zoned. Hence, the town was zoned and new homes blossomed in what is known as "the Downs."

Residents stepped up to the plate and voted millage to improve the water and sewer systems. Streets were hard surfaced and street lights were installed. A Department of Public Works was established with adequate staffing. The Fire Department built a new station and added upto-date fire and ambulance equipment. The police staffing became a contractual entity of the Barry County Sheriff's department.

## . . . a place to call home!



Perhaps the biggest improvement in Middleville has been the funding of the educational system. In the early 1930's William K. Kellogg gave monies to several Barry County districts for building new consolidated school buildings - hence we became The Thornapple Kellogg school district. In 1956 there about 700 students in the TK district (now numbering over 3,300). Buses 65 years ago were a far cry from the modern buses today.

When it became obvious in the middle 60's that we were running out of space, the community again stepped up and agreed to bond for a new high school. That was followed by building two more elementary schools, and a new middle school.

Through the more modern times all of these structures have been added onto and improved - again by a favorable bond vote by the community.

Middleville is recognized as one of Michigan's most progressive communities. We truly are a place where in the vision of America's founders wrote: "We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty, and the pursuit of Happiness." Let us continue our pursuit.





#### At the Village . . . .

The Village of Middleville is a progressive and zoned community of over 4,000 residents who enjoy a high quality of life at least in part because of their pleasant rural surroundings, convenient public infrastructures and close proximity to all attractions and amenities of the Grand Rapids metropolitan area.

Founded in 1834 and incorporated in 1868, Middleville is a General Law Village governed by a Council-Manager form of government. The elected seven member Council meets the second and fourth Tuesday of each month at the Village Hall.

The village offices are open daily 9 am to 5 pm. Payments may be made at the office for village taxes each September, as well as quarterly water and sewer billings.

Police protection is provided by contract with the Barry County Sheriff's department, with a police sub-station at the Village Hall.

#### At the Township . . . .

The Township of Thornapple is 36 square miles located in the northwest corner of Barry County. Although rural in nature, growth in the township has become home to over 9,000 people. Much of the land in western Thornapple features some of the most productive farmland in the County.

The Township is governed by a seven member board that meets the second Monday of each month at the Township Hall. Property assessments in the township, including Middleville, is under the jurisdiction of the Township. The Assessor has an office at the Township Hall and the Board of Review meets annually to hear property value concerns. Planning and Zoning is by ordinance and the use of property by landowners requires a zoning compliance permit.

The administration of elections (in the township, village and school district) is the responsibility of the township clerk. The township also administers Mt. Hope and Parmalee cemeteries.

The Thornapple Township Emergency Services operates the fire and ambulance service 24/7. For more information contact



## Thornapple Kellogg Schools Where Kids Come First

Welcome to TK Schools! The word "family" and "community" are frequently used to describe what's so special about TK Schools.

Our students and staff are surrounded by an extremely supportive and caring community and with that support our students enjoy achievements, opportunities, success, and a feeling of security and belonging.

Thornapple Kellogg Schools is **committed** to providing the social, physical educational needs of each student so they will be successful in learning and prepared with options for their future.

We look to our district mission statement "Encouraging and Developing the Greatest Potential of Each Student," in everything we do as we prepare students for life beyond high school. The Board of Education adopts a five-year strategic plan with input from parents, community members and teachers. This plan provides a guideline future goals of the district. The latest plan set four specific focus areas: Teaching and learning; school and community engagement; facilities and infrastructure; and finance and budget. With specific goals established in each area the Board of Education, administrators, teachers and staff work together to meet these those goals.

TK is fortunate to enjoy the support and help from an extremely encouraging and supportive community to help to meet those challenges. Our graduates have found meaningful and successful careers close to home, across the country and around the globe.

Who We Are: Thornapple Kellogg Schools has a rich history of pride, class and tradition, The district is named for Thornapple Township and the Thornapple river that runs through the district and for W.K. Kellogg of cereal fame who helped establish the consolidated district in the 1930s. Hence our name!

Today, enrollment in Young 5's through 12th grades is approximately 3,200 students. We continue seeing growth with many families choosing TK Schools and seeking places to live and raise their families within the 125 square-mile boundaries. The district is primarily located in northwestern Barry County, but also reaches into parts of northeast Allegan, southern Kent, and south-western Ionia counties.

Today, the district is home to three elementary schools, one middle school and one high school, all located with the Village of Middleville. Our unique configuration builds a sense of community from the first day of school. McFall houses all the young 5's, kindergarten and first grade students; Lee is home to second and third grades; Page is our upper elementary home for fourth and fifth grades. The middle school is especially designed for our sixth, seventh and eighth grade classes before they move on to the high school for their last four years at TK.





In addition, the district also has a new **Early Childhood Center** (*shownabove*) which opened in 2022. This building houses all preschool programs, including early childhood special education opportunities, to help prepare all our future TK Trojans for kindergarten success. The Center also provides space for before, after and summer childcare programs and a beautiful meeting room for the Board of Education and public meetings.

Throughout the district, each of our schools use positive interventions and supports: **TrueSuccess Program and Capturing Kids' Hearts.** Each of these programs are designed to build meaningful relationships between students and teachers and encourage positive behaviors and reward true successes.



TK Schools is a member of the **Kent Intermediate School District** which provides our students numerous educational opportunities offered through Kent Center Technical Center. By being a member of one of the largest ISD's in the state, Thornapple Kellogg also benefits from the availability of a wide variety of professional development and support services.

Our Community is an integral piece of our district's success and well-being of all students. We take pride in our students, our schools and our community. TK is a special place because of the support, dedication and care from our community we serve. It's clear, the

goals of providing the best education, opportunities, ansupports go far beyond the classroom walls. As a district we recognize the immeasurable value of continuing to have ongoing involvement and communication with the entire TK community – families, businesses, service organizations, government and other agencies.

As the largest employer in Barry County and southwest Michigan, Bradford White has over 1,600 men and women working to send 80 truckloads of heaters daily for domestic, commercial and industrial use.

**ChemQuest,** located on Crane Road, supplies cleaning agents for industrial use, They also make equipment for painting plastics and metals for manufacturing.


**Hydraulic Specialties,** located on Eagle Drive, manufactures hydraulic pumps of many types. They ship pumps to locations around the world.

Accurate Machine and Tool, one of the newest firms to locate in Middleville, is a major supplier to Brandford White and other Grand Rapids area manufacturers. It is located on the corner of Crane Road and Grand Rapids Street.



## Calvin Hill Founded Middleville In 1834



Only woods, wolves and Indians greeted Calvin Hill in 1834 when he came to settle on the banks of the Thornapple River in the area now known as Middleville. After purchasing 400 acres on each side of the river, he went back to his native New York state and returned with his family.

It wasn't long before other pioneers followed from the Eastern United States. These folks recognized the farming potential of the land surrounding the settlement of Middleville, and for the first 100 years of the community Middleville was the hub of an agrarian society, The town grew to serve 40, 80 acres or more farmers with mills, horse related businesses and retail stores for their other needs. The Thornapple River provided power for the mills and eventually saw a dam emplaced for electrical power.

Those were the days when the stagecoach stopped on its way from Battle Creek to Grand Rapids, and the town was named Middleville because of its convenient location between those two towns. By 1838 the first school in Barry County was opened in Middleville. After the frame school building was out dated, the community built a brick building on land where Calvin Hill Park is now located. By the 1930's the rural school districts were incorporated with the Middleville village school district and a new school building with the help from William K. Kellogg was constructed on the community's west side.

Middleville has been chiefly an agricultural center with a flourishing farmers' market, a grain mill that operated on a twenty-four hour basis and became famous for its Lily White flour shipped throughout the Midwest. A Farmers Cooperative Creamery which turned a ton of butter daily also put Middleville on the map.

The community has always welcomed industrial companies to Middleville. The long list of past industries includes a corset stay manufacturer, a shoe factory, a brass fitting company, automotive parts supplier and baby wear gift company. In 1939 Jerry White moved his water heater plant from Lansing to Middleville.

By the late 1950's the community began to change from an agrarian focus to other establishments. With the improvements of roads, automobile sales and service stations began to pop up. In downtown Middleville there was a bank, a drug store, a movie theater, hardware stores, grocery stores and a meat market. When M-37 was constructed to go north from the stoplight on Main street, more commercial enterprises were founded.

Unfortunately with the rise of better roads and automobiles, the lure of commercial malls in Grand Rapids nailed the demise of Middleville's retail businesses, The community has responded in "modern times" with more service companies and specialty shops. Middleville has become home to new folks as 100's of new homes have been built. Since the early 1950's the population of Middleville has swelled from 1,000 people to over 4,000!



## Middleville Area Veterans Memorial

IN 2010 SHORTLY after the loss of Middleville's second Post 9/11 fallen soldier in 2009, a group of citizens wanted to recognize Middleville's veteran community. After years of community support and a dedicated Friends of Veterans committee the Middleville Area Veterans Memorial was dedicated in August of 2017. The Memorial contains a wall of the thirteen Middleville service members who paid the ultimate price with their lives. In front of the KIA wall are 300 veteran pavers, listing the name, rank, branch

and service dates of Middleville veterans. The smaller walls of the Memorial have the following inscription: "Some Gave All" and "All Gave Some." Both groups are well represented in the Memorial.

The Memorial, shown above adjacent to the Downtown Sesquicentennial Park, overlooks the Historic Train Depot and the Thornapple Township Emergency Services station in the background.

Each year the community observes Memorial Day ceremonies and Veteran's Day. Both of these special days gives our citizens an opportunity to remember the sacrifices these veterans gave in defense of our nation, the United States of America.



## **Exploring Feasibility of Stand-Alone Public Library**

THE MIDDLVILLE LIBRARY for the past 90 years has been a part of the Thornapple Kellogg school system. The library has followed the TK district as it has been enlarged. It resided in the Kellogg sponsored high school in the 1930's, moved within that building in the 60's and became a part of the new high school in 70's. When the high school was recently remodeled a new library room for the public and students was added.

With new safety concerns in the operation of the Library, it has been necessary to limit the public to the building. With this in mind, a group of concerned citizens in the district began to explore the feasibility of a stand-alone Library building. 




## Middleville is the Place For Activities and Fun

## Village of Middleville Street Map








